

FOX FIRE VILLAGE POOL - RULES AND POLICIES

*****Pool Facility is under 24-hour Video Surveillance*****

Lifeguards are present to ensure the safety and appropriate behavior of all patrons. Complaints concerning pool operations and pool staff should be made to the Pool Director, Lisa Kivett. Lifeguards have the authority to remove a swimmer from the pool and/or pool facility for violation of any rules.

- ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES and GLASS CONTAINERS are **NOT PERMITTED**.
- **NO SMOKING** inside the pool facility. Smoking permitted in designated area ONLY.
- NO person(s) shall be in the pool area UNLESS a Lifeguard is on duty and **ONLY DURING SCHEDULED POOL HOURS**. Entering the pool facility before or after scheduled hours is **TRESPASSING and subject to fines set by the Courts**.
- Lifeguards are responsible for overseeing all patrons of the pool and cannot be responsible for watching unaccompanied children. **(Lifeguards are not Babysitters!)**
- ALL children under the age of 6 must be accompanied by an adult while in the water. No child under the age of 13 is permitted to be left alone at the pool facility.
- All swimmers must take showers before entering the pool in order to comply with State Health Codes.
- **NO DIVING ALLOWED**
- No Diapers allowed in the pool. Rubber pants or swimming pants are **REQUIRED**. Swimming pants must have elastic in leg area.
- Non-swimmers must stay in the shallow end.
- **NO PETS ALLOWED** except Service Dogs.
- **No Band-Aids or open wounds in the pool**. Long hair must be pulled back in a hair tie. Bathing caps are **not required**.
- No patrons allowed in Lifeguard chairs, stands or behind the Lifeguard counter.
- **NO HORSEPLAY**, such as **splashing, shoving or dunking**, is allowed.
- No hanging on safety lines.
- **NO RUNNING and JUMPING**, or doing **FLIPS OFF THE SIDE OF THE POOL**
- No hard balls or toys in the pool.
- NO personal flotation devices (rafts or boats) allowed. **Children's "water wings" are permitted**
- **NO GUM CHEWING or eating of food in the pool**.
- No glass or metal containers/objects allowed in the pool, deck, or bathhouse.
- All trash **MUST** be placed in trash receptacles. Plastic Water Bottles and Aluminum Cans must be placed in the recycling receptacle. **Please empty liquids first**.
- Food containers **MUST** be taken with you when leaving pool facility.
- Please report any accidents, damage to pool or equipment and possible contamination **immediately** to the Pool Manager or Lifeguard.
- **DO NOT FLUSH** sanitary products in toilets. **As a courtesy to others, USE** receptacles provided in each bathroom stall. Please **DO NOT** put disposable diapers in trash can!
